Health Warranty

Oopsie Doodles of NC/KY cares for your dog from birth to the homecoming date. Your dog is believed to be in good health and is sold in good faith. Your dog has received a clean bill of health from our local veterinarian prior to homecoming.

The Buyer agrees to have the puppy inspected by a practicing veterinarian within 3 working days of contract to ensure the two year health guarantee on life-inhibiting genetic defects. If the buyer declines health warranty or does not submit documentation of first veterinarian visit then the health guarantee is invalidated.

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Care and Maintenance

The Buyer agrees to maintain your dog's health by providing routine and preventative health care including: vaccinations, parasite prevention, medications

according to the proper protocol established by a licensed vet (not purchased online or at a farm store).

The Buyer agrees to maintain the dog's health by feeding high quality food (24-26% protein, rated 4.5 stars or higher on website: Dog Food Advisor (dogfoodadvisor.com)). The health warranty will be voided if the dog is allowed to become overweight.

The health guarantee covers the following genetic conditions: Degenerative Myelopathy, Neonatal Encephalopathy with Seizures, Progressive Retinal Atrophy types 1 and 2, Progressive Rod/Cone Degeneration, GM2 Gangliosidosis, Osteochondrodysplasia, and Von Willebrand Disease.

Additionally, the warranty includes coverage for cancer, hip dysplasia, genetic eye disorders, and seizure disorders (only if topical flea/tick treatments are used, NOT oral medications).

Should the Orthopedic Foundation for Animals (OFA) diagnose the puppy with hip dysplasia before the age of two, the Buyer must provide a copy of the OFA report to Oopsie Doodles of NC/KY. Hip and elbow dysplasia can result from environmental factors, including obesity, early spaying/neutering (before 12 months), and excessive exercise in young dogs. Thus, the Buyer agrees to maintain a healthy weight and to spay/neuter after puberty (after 12 months).

Reimbursement for genetic defects will only be issued upon receipt of a second opinion from a qualified veterinarian and proof of surgery costs. An official OFA hip rating will suffice as a second opinion. In the rare event of the puppy's death, a replacement will be provided free of charge if the puppy is under two years old and a necropsy conducted by a qualified veterinarian determines that a genetic issue caused the death. **No reimbursement will be granted without a necropsy report. This warranty is void if the diagnosis is inconclusive or indeterminate.**

Warranties apply solely to the original purchaser. If the puppy is diagnosed with any of the aforementioned genetic conditions within two years, a statement from a veterinarian on official letterhead confirming the genetic condition is required. Oopsie Doodles of NC will then reclaim ownership of the affected puppy (if the Buyer wishes) and provide a replacement from the next available litter. Oopsie Doodles of NC will not refund transportation costs or veterinary expenses, and we do not buy back dogs or puppies.

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Rehoming Agreement

If for any reason (other than genetic issues) the Buyer determines they cannot keep their dog, the Buyer agrees to contact Oopsie Doodles of NC/KY to make arrangements to return the dog. The Buyer agrees that the dog shall not be surrendered to a shelter or animal rescue. The owner agrees to terminate rights to the dog; no money will be refunded; and the dog will be matched to a suitable home at Oopsie Doodle of NC/KY's discretion.

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Spay and Neuter Agreement

Our puppies are sold strictly as pets. As part of the agreement, your pet is required to be spayed or neutered. Growth hormones play a role in bone density and can help prevent urinary incontinence post-spaying. The buyer agrees to keep the puppy sexually intact until it reaches 12 months of age for the health warranty to remain valid. In addition, the buyer must provide documentation to Oopsie Doodles of NC/KY after the pet has been spayed or neutered.

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Disclosures / Non-Disparagement

Oopsie Doodles of NC has taken every care with breeding, rearing and the welfare of your new dog. Prior to purchase, your Oopsie Doodles puppy was declared healthy by a licensed veterinarian. Your dog is believed to be in good health and it is sold in good faith.

Disclaimer Regarding Health Risks in Commercial Transport for Puppies

Please do note that commercial transporters often have many puppies from various breeders together in their vehicle, which may lead to the contraction of health issues

due to close proximity. Therefore, Oopsie Doodles of NC/KY cannot be held liable for any illnesses contracted after your puppy leaves our home.

Health Disclaimer and Parasite Prevention Protocol for Our Puppies

ALL puppies are born with parasites, and the stress of transitioning to a new home can reactivate dormant parasites, infections, or viruses. Our puppies receive Pyrantel deworming medicine at ages 2, 4, and 6 weeks to prevent pinworms, roundworms, and hookworms. Additionally, our puppies receive Ponazuril at age five weeks to prevent coccidiosis and Interceptor Plus (heartworm prevention) at age 8 weeks.

However, puppies can still have parasites that resist treatment. Your veterinarian should provide routine deworming and/or fecal tests to treat according to their findings. Oopsie Doodles will not reimburse the buyer for any veterinary bills related to such issues. All veterinarian records must be submitted to Oopsie Doodles of NC/KY if the health warranty is called into question.

The health warranty does not cover viral illnesses, parasites, infections, hernias, improper bites, giardia, coccidiosis or kennel cough.

Additionally, it does not cover illnesses due to the ingestion of foreign objects, food, chemicals, stress related conditions or behavioral issues. All veterinarian records must be submitted to Oopsie Doodles of NC if the health warranty is called into question.

Our 2-year health warranty covers life-inhibiting genetic defects. If the warranty is exercised within the 2-year period, the breeder will offer a replacement puppy. To qualify, detailed veterinary records and a report confirming any potential diagnosis within the scope of the health guarantee must be provided.

Vaccination and Preventative Disclaimers

A licensed veterinarian has conducted examinations on the puppies and administered the appropriate DHPP vaccinations based on the puppy's age. It is important to note that there is a series of vaccinations required. Puppies are susceptible to contracting deadly diseases like Parvovirus and distemper in public places, so they should not be taken to dog parks until the full vaccination series is completed. It is safe for puppies to interact with other vaccinated dogs for socialization.

Administering additional vaccinations too early can lead to autoimmune diseases, so no further vaccinations should be given until three weeks after the initial DHPP vaccination. Optional vaccines, such as Lyme, Bordetella, Lepto, and Canine Flu, should be delayed if possible, and individual risk factors should be considered before administering these optional vaccines. If necessary, the Lepto vaccine should be administered separately due to common reactions. The FDA has linked oral flea and tick medications to seizures; therefore, the buyer agrees to use only topical flea/tick medications like Seresto collars or Frontline. Any use of oral flea and tick preventatives will void the health warranty.

Disposition and Coat

The breeder makes no warranty as to the disposition of your dog. Breeder makes no warranty on the color or texture of your dog's coat as these can change as he/she grows.

Buyer understands that the purchase price is nonrefundable. No dog is 100 percent hypoallergenic and Oopsie Doodles of NC does not imply that all allergy sufferers can tolerate a doodle puppy. Oopsie Doodles of NC does not guarantee that a puppy will grow to a specific size as many factors determine adult size, including food and exercise. Under no circumstances shall the Seller be liable to the Buyer or to any third party for a dog that has been subjected to abuse, accident, negligence or misuse. Also, under no circumstances shall the Seller be liable for any consequential incidental or special damages resulting from or in any manner related to the dog. **If an Oopsie Doodle ever needs to be rehomed, for any reason, the buyer agrees to return the dog to Oopsie Doodles of NC to assess and rehome with NO REFUND due to the customer.** All puppies require training; therefore, the buyer agrees to teach the puppy house manners and basic dog obedience. We highly recommend and suggest Baxter & Bella, an online training resource.

Dispute Resolution and Non-Disparagement Agreement

Buyer and Breeder agree that in the event of a dispute neither will publish or communicate the existence or content of such dispute in any media or forum, including social media. Owner agrees to not disparage, criticize or defame Breeder, its affiliates and their respective affiliates either publicly or privately. The Breeder agrees that it shall not, and it shall instruct its affiliates to not disparage, criticize or defame the owner either publicly or privately. This contract is legally binding in the state of North Carolina and Kentucky. All parties agree that any court actions to enforce this contract will be filed in Camden County, NC or Jefferson County, KY.

Buyer/Owner understands and accepts the terms of this contract and agrees to abide by the terms outlined herein.
